Fertility & Growth!

Growth is great, but do ensure that EBV's suit your property and management.

At a recent North Canterbury field day, it was conceded that the target yearling mating weight for heifers had increased 10% to meet consistent pregnancy rates previously achieved with lower growth EBV's.

High performance was being achieved from an intensive artificial insemination and bull investment program, pasture renewal and trace element supplementation. However heifers had to be heavier to continue to breed in a 30 - 50 day period.

Those attending the field day were told there were three important aspects to performance, nutrition, nutrition and nutrition.

Sensible Balance required in Breeding Programs

At Stern we are continuing to take a balanced approach to breeding functional cattle. It is easy to rapidly increase herd EBV's by use of extreme genetics but, if Australia and America are a guide then we'll see those herds move to a greater emphasis on feet, leg structure, hind quarters and fertility. While there has been good progress made in areas such as carcass traits, breeders do appreciate other areas have been neglected.

Larger eye muscle EBV's don't necessarily mean

larger hind quarters but it's the hind quarter muscle and correct leg structure that's essential for cattle to move around and forage on our New Zealand hill country. Australia and America simply don't have steep hill country like much of New Zealand's cow country.

We will, and have used top growth and carcass sires to blend with our New Zealand blood lines but culling is heavy.

Stern has not had a commercial bull breakdown in years. The soundness of our bulls is guaranteed!
